DOCUMENTS


- * Progress reports / report cards
- * IEP / other service plans
- * Medical records
- * Formal notices
- Disability Information
- Classroom / School Tests
- Discipline / Behavior documents, including suspensions, intervention plans, progress notes

- * Evaluations: school / private
- * IEP Progress Notes
- * Standardized test results
- * Invoices
- * Agency Resources



Portfolio: Keeping Organized

NOTES



- * Correspondence (email, notes, letter) from school team professionals
- * Notes from conversations / meetings
- * Discipline / Behavior notes from teacher / agenda book
- * Child's work samples



Portfolio: Life Book

- ► A collection of pictures, writing, and work samples that create a view of all aspects of the child's life, including family, school, religious, community, medical
- Builds the child's journey rather than start over each year
- Valuable information for knowing the child beyond the disability
- Guide to values and activities of the family
